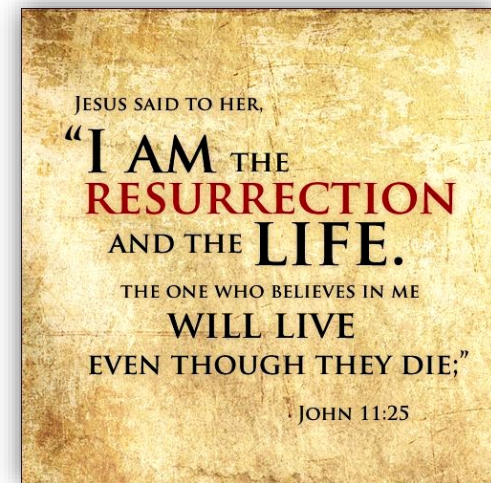
PRAYER REQUESTS:
