WEEKLY ADVENT GUIDE

Week Two: Peace

Week two of Advent focuses on the prophecies immediately surrounding Jesus' birth. These accounts reveal God's divine interaction with ordinary men and women, altering the course of their journeys forever. Where has God intervened in your story? 
