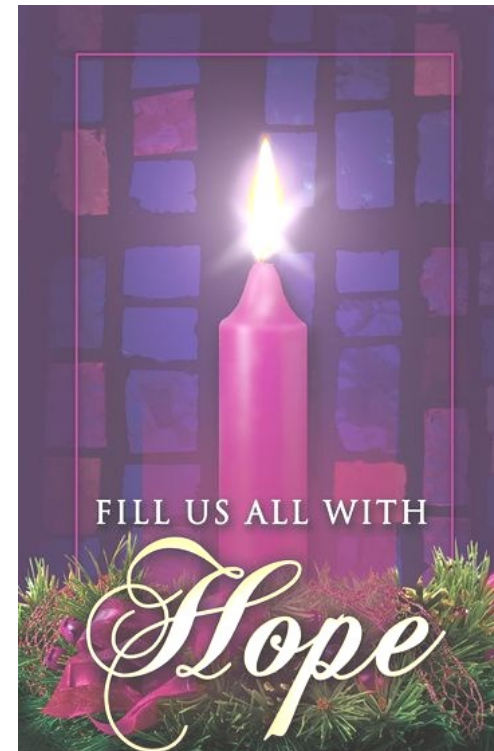

officers, teachers and leaders for the 2026 church year.


